

PRIVACY POLICY

This is the Privacy Policy of 222 CONSULTING B.V (hereinafter referred to as "222 CONSULTING," "we," "us" or "our"), a company having its address at 382 Laan van Avant-Garde, 3059RA ROTTERDAM. 222 CONSULTING is registered with the Chamber of Commerce under number 95498826. Our Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, share and protect information in relation to our website www.222consulting.nl (the "Service"). We collect this information when you visit our website with your computer, tablet, phone or smartwatch ("Computer"). We process personal data in a manner that is in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (the "GDPR"), the GDPR-based legislation and the other current privacy legislation.

By using the Service, you understand and agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Our Privacy Policy applies to all visitors, users, and others who access the Service ("Users").

What kinds of information do we collect?

Information you provide

We collect the following information you provide us with directly:

- a. Communications between you and 222 CONSULTING (e.g., we may send you Service-related emails);

Log file information

We collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Service. This log file information may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages and other statistics.

Purposes of processing data

By using our Service, you leave certain information with us, for example by creating an account. This may include data such as name, e-mail address, place of residence, telephone number and payment details. 222 Consulting collects and processes this data to make our services accessible. Legal basis for processing data

How do we use this information?

- c. monitor metrics such as total number of visitors, traffic, and demographic patterns;

- d. diagnose or fix technology problems;

How is this information shared?

We will not rent or sell your information to third parties outside 222 CONSULTING.

Change of control

If we sell or otherwise transfer part or the whole of 222 CONSULTING or our assets to another organization (e.g., in the course of a transaction like a merger, acquisition, bankruptcy, dissolution, liquidation), your information collected through the Service may be among the items sold or transferred. The buyer or transferee will have to honor the commitments we have made in this Privacy Policy.

Legal requests and preventing harm

We may access, preserve and share your information in response to a legal request (like a search warrant, court order or subpoena) if we have a good faith belief that the law requires us to do so. We may also access, preserve and share information when we have a good faith belief it is necessary to: detect, prevent and address fraud and other illegal activity; to protect ourselves, you and others, including as part of investigations; and to prevent death or imminent bodily harm. Information we receive about you may be accessed, processed and retained for an extended period of time when it is the subject of a legal request or obligation, governmental investigation, or investigations concerning possible violations of our terms or policies, or otherwise to prevent harm.

Safety and security

222 CONSULTING has taken appropriate technical and organizational measures by using the latest technologies to protect your information against loss or unlawful processing. We use safeguards to help keep the information collected through the Service secure. However, 222 CONSULTING cannot ensure the security of any information you transmit to 222 CONSULTING or guarantee that information on the Service may not be accessed, disclosed, altered, or destroyed. We request you to do your part to help us. You are responsible for controlling access to emails between you and 222 CONSULTING, at all times. We are not responsible for the functionality, privacy, or security measures of any other organization.

Retention period

In accordance with the law, 222 CONSULTING does not retain data any longer than is required for attaining the purposes for which they were collected unless 222 CONSULTING is obliged to do so based on a legal provision.
